Our school is conducting the annual Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey offered by the Department of Education and is seeking your feedback. The survey is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour, and

student engagement. The survey is optional, but we encourage and appreciate your participation. Our school will use the survey results to assist in identifying areas for improvement and professional development needs in the school, to target school planning and improvement strategies.

The Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey will be open online from **Monday 29 July to Friday 30 August 2024**.

All families will be invited to participate in the survey.

The link to the survey will be posted on our Compass App on Monday.

The survey will be conducted **online**, only takes **20 minutes** to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones.

The online survey will be available in English and 10 other languages including Arabic, Greek, Hakha Chin, Hindi, Japanese, Punjabi, Simplified Chinese, Somali, Turkish, and Vietnamese. Resources are also available in additional languages to assist

Late Arrivals and Early Departures from School

Parents and carers need to be aware that students who arrive late to school **must come via the office, accompanied by a parent/carer, to have their entry recorded into the Compass Kiosk. They will receive a late slip to hand to their teacher and to have their arrival at school recorded.**

Similarly parents/carers must sign their child/ren out at the school office on the Compass Kiosk if they need to pick their child/ren up early from school.

If children are returned to school, parents are to accompany their child/ren to the office and have their arrival recorded at the school office via the Compass App or by office staff.

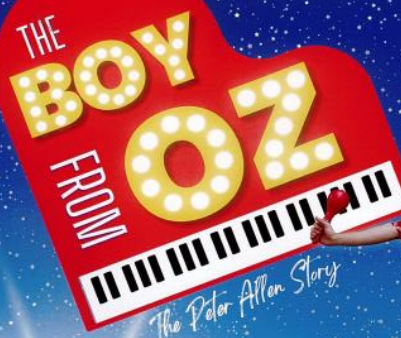
