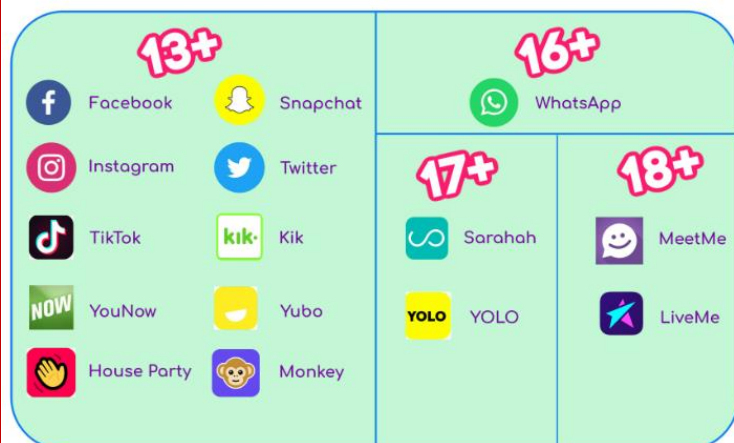

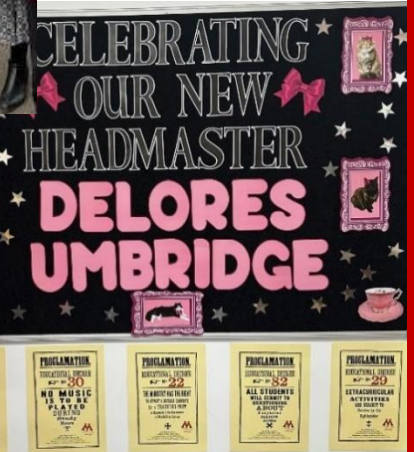
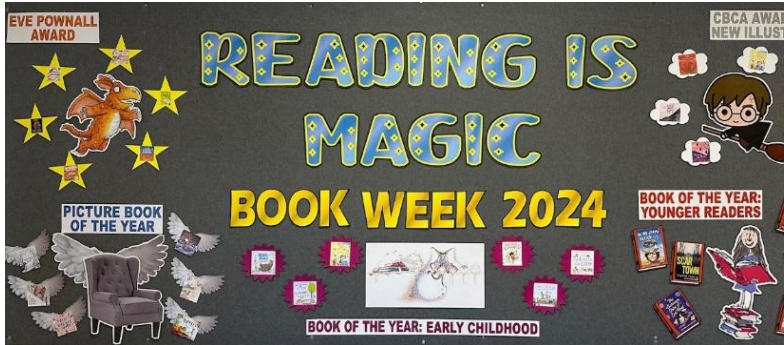


BOOK WEEK AT 545

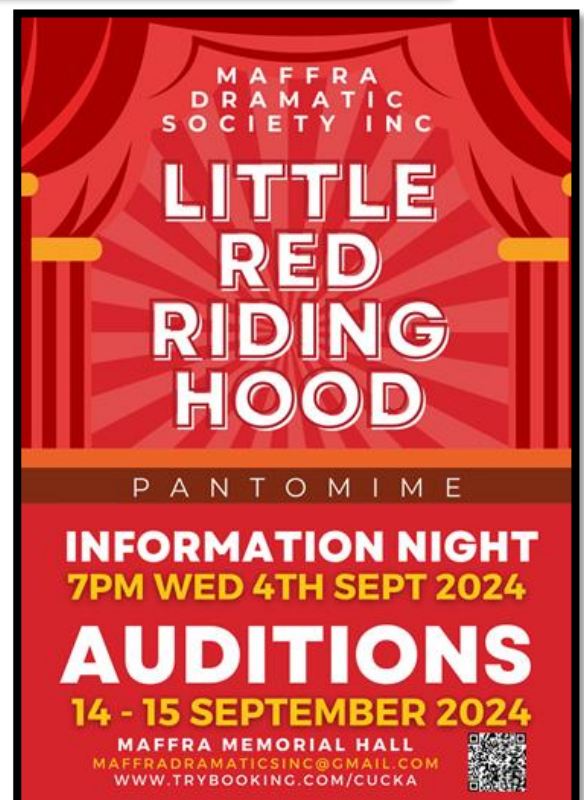
