We ask that our families be mindful of parking in the bus bay area and local nature strips and driveways, during morning and afternoon drop off/pick up times.


The Wellington Shire do monitor parking around our school.




Since it began in 2005, more than 4.5 million young readers have taken part and together read more than 63 million books!
