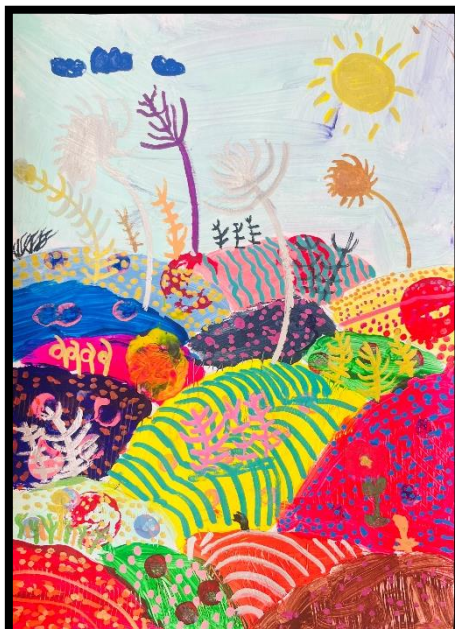
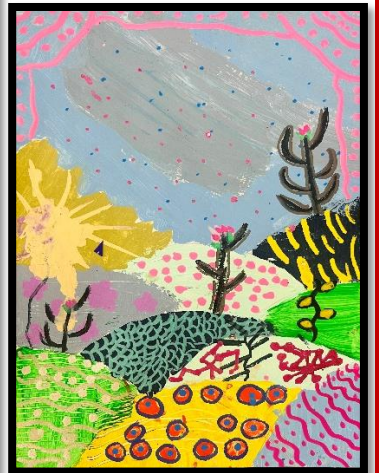
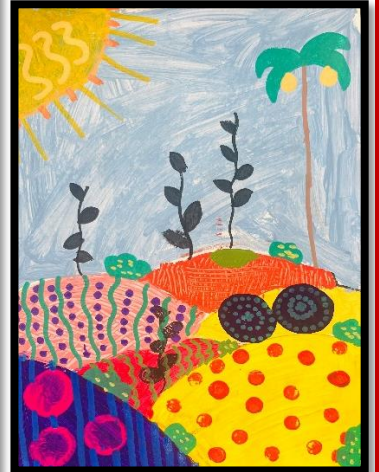
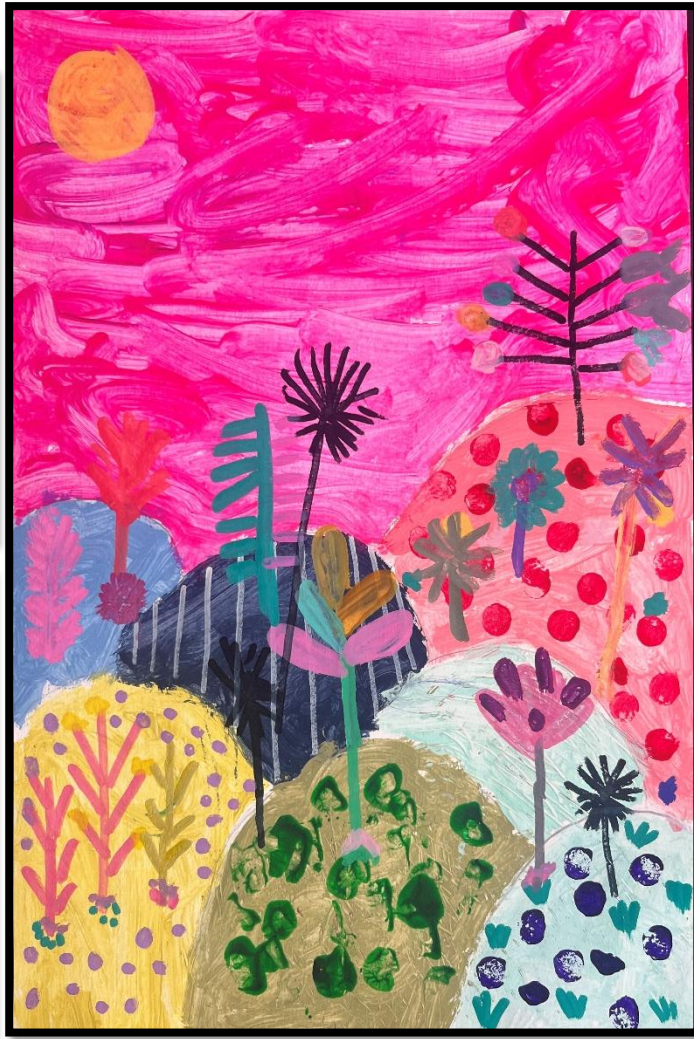




## Art News – Lou Cooper
