National Simultaneous Story Time 2026



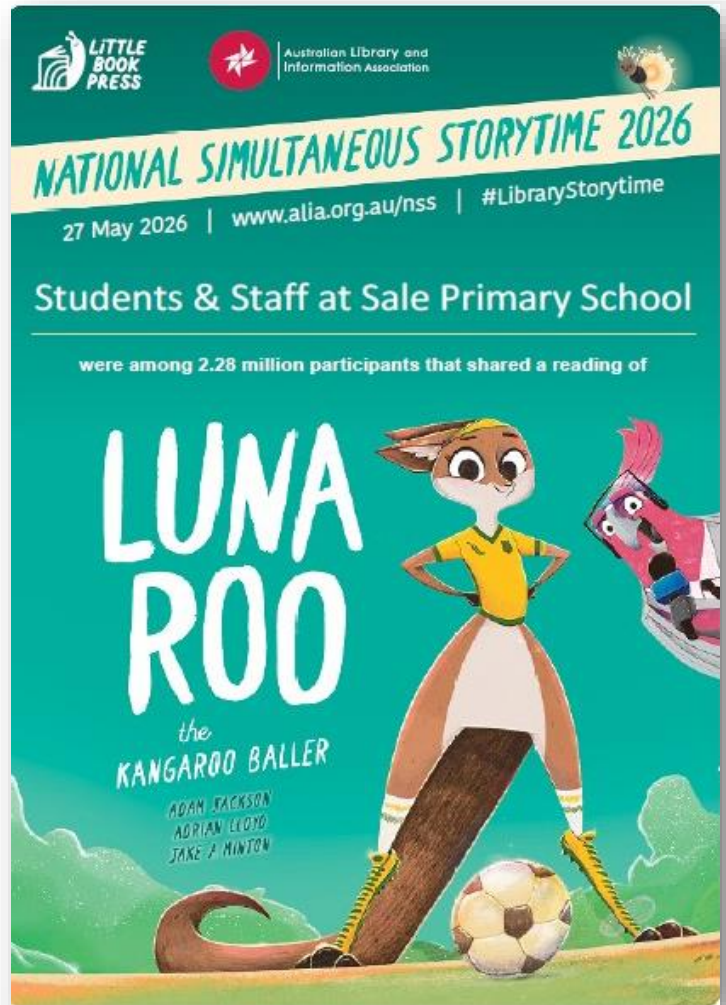
Sale Primary School recently participated in the annual National Simultaneous Storytime event, held in Market Square.
