NEALE DANIHER AO

15 February 1961 –

25 May 2026

A State Funeral Service for Neale Daniher AO will be held tomorrow, Wednesday June 10, at the Melbourne

Cricket Ground.

In 2013, Neale was diagnosed with motor neurone disease (MND), or 'The Beast' as he called it. Determined to help others living with the disease, Neale co-founded FightMND. Together with his family and supporters, FightMND has committed over \$141 million to medical research and care, to improve the lives of those living with MND, and to find treatments and ultimately a cure.

Neale was named the Victorian of the Year in 2019 and the Australian of the Year in 2025, in recognition of his extraordinary contributions in leading the fight against MND, inspiring millions of Australians with hope.

In remembrance, the Australian National Flag at Sale Primary School will be flown at half-mast along with all buildings and establishments occupied by Victorian Government departments and affiliated agencies tomorrow, Wednesday June 10, 2026.

Foundation students have been getting their clay on. They have been learning how to roll a clay coil, make it into a spiral and create cute little snails! After oil pastelling and painting their clay snails they drew and painted their snails onto paper using the same pastel and paint colours. Juniors have been learning about Piet Mondrian- a famous 20th Century geometric abstract artist. They recreated his iconic works using black paint slicks painted onto the thin side of a foam piece and stamping it onto paper to create all different sized squares and rectangles. They then pastel and painted these in the primary colours of red, yellow and blue.

Participation

We're sitting these competitions via the AMT competition platform which means personal information about your child, including their first and last name, date of birth, gender, school and school year will be recorded in AMT's online platform.

AMT also publish the results of its competitions and activities on its website, which may include information such as the student's name, school, school year, state, award and score as well as the names of award winners and/or medalists.

AMT has advised that the personal information is kept in their competition servers which are physically located in Australia, however they use an online provider platform based in the Netherlands for competition processing and analysis. Back-up servers are located in the Netherlands. AMT deliver the competitions, and use the personal information, in accordance with the AMT's Privacy Policy.
